This month's highlights:

### Parking:

Isn't parking always a highlight? We know that it can be difficult to find parking in front of your business at any point during the day. To help offset this, please remember that there are lots of options for your employees for parking within the downtown core. The parking garage, Stampede lot, Dewey Lot, Longbranch, and Academy lot are all leased parking places for your employees. Contact Code Enforcement for signup to lease a spot. 208-468-5473.

You can also contact Max Chavez to acquire a paid parking spot in the dirt lot located at the corner of 13th Ave S. and 1st St S. His phone # is 208-550-5691.

Parking in these places allows MORE parking for YOUR customers.

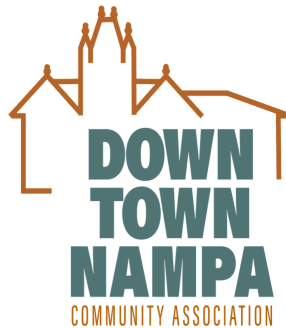
